## Hanoi, December 11 - 13, 2008

ICT-Hanoi 2008 is the second in a series of annual international Hanoi Forum on Information-Communication Technology, which is organized by Vietnam National University, Hanoi (VNU) and sponsored by The Korea Foundation for Advanced Studies (KFAS). The forum aims at providing a platform for scientists, engineers, practitioners, managers, businessmen, government leaders, *etc.* from countries to exchange new ideas and experiences and to discuss opportunities, challenges, solutions, practice/application models and a roadmap for ICT development in Vietnam in particular.
